### Snow Site Management Program Achievements



Snow and ice removal is a common task for maintaining roadways, parking lots, and other pathways during the winter. For many municipalities, like The City of Edmonton, centralized snow facilities located around the area are used to store collected snow while minimizing environmental impacts. The facilities are set up to treat the sediment laden meltwater, which can damage fish habitats, through the use of a detention pond.
